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Frequently Asked Questions

1. What grades will my child need to participate in prom?

Students must have a D average or above in core content classes, which includes reading, math, science, and social studies.

2. What grades will my child need to participate in promotion?

Students must pass all core content classes with a final grade of a D or above, which includes reading, math, science, and social studies.

3. If my child fails any core content course (reading, math, science, social studies) can they participate in promotion?

No. The student must attend summer school in order to be promoted to high school if they fail reading, math, science, and/or social studies. Summer school dates are July 5-August 5th, 2022. Parents must complete registration for summer school.

4. How does my child know if he/she is currently eligible to participate in EOY activities?

Student eligibility is determined based on report grades. In addition, students will receive a letter indicating eligibility for EOY activities.

5. Do I have to pay the full amount for each activity at once or can I make payments?

You do not have to pay the full amount at one time. You can make payments, as long as the total amount is paid by the final due date of Monday, May 2, 2022.

6. Who should receive payments for End of Year activities?

Payments will be submitted in the front office to Mrs. Henderson or Ms. Jackson. As payments are received a receipt will be issued.

7. Can I receive a refund for end of the year activities once paid in full?

Yes, refunds will be issued for any reason up until Monday, May 2, 2022. After Monday, May 2, 2022 no refunds will be issued because all money will be submitted to the necessary vendor.

**The principal or grade level administrator reserves the right to deny student participation based on egregious behavior. Egregious behavior can be defined as fighting, disrespect towards school staff, bringing a weapon to school, and students consistently out of location. Refer to DCMR Chapter 25 for an exhaustive list of behavior infractions. Students with three out of school suspensions for SY 21-22 will not be allowed to participate in end of year activities.*

If a student has NOT met the 8th grade promotion participation requirements, he/she will NOT be permitted to attend the 8th grade field trip, may NOT participate in the promotion ceremony, nor may attend the prom.
